Field of Application

The aluminum foil can be used for direct contact with dry, moist and fatty foods. Contact between the aluminum foil and very acidic or very salty food should be avoided, since they have a detrimental effect on the aluminum.

The foil can be used up to 300 °C for an unlimited period. It can also be used for storing food at room temperature or colder (incl. freezer). Make sure the food cools down before stored under chilled conditions. The condensation that may occur can cause discoloration.

Avoid direct contact with electric parts and direct flames.

The aluminum products only to be used in microwave ovens if the microwave oven itself allows the use of it.
