Area of Use

The paper sheets can be used safely for all types of food except for acidic foods at maximum +70°C.

They should not be used for microwave ovens.

Various foods may affect the physical properties of wood. Duni advises customers to test their applications for suitability.

Packaging and Packaging Waste

The product and packaging comply with all essential requirements of Directive 94/62/EC on packaging and packaging waste as well as the forthcoming Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR), Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

Environmental Aspects**Product**

The paper is made from unbleached pulp consisting of 100% virgin fibres and the the LDPE plastic originates from fossil sources.

PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) are not being used in any step of the manufacturing of the paper sheet.

PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) are **not** being used in any step of the manufacturing of the products covered by this data sheet.

Packaging

The corrugated board box is unbleached and to a large extent made of recycled fibres.

End of Life

Recycling

Collection, sorting and material recovery are all part of the recycling process. Recycling is dependent on local waste handling infrastructure.

Used products should be handled according to local regulations, for best guidance, please check with local waste handling company.

Recycling of the packaging material is possible.

Energy Recovery

Incineration facilities for energy recovery are dependent on local infrastructure. Incineration for energy recovery is a good alternative when material recovery is not available by recycling.
