Unbleached Kraft paper
Tissue (the napkin)

Inner: Carboard
Outer: Corrugated board box

Area of Use

Sacchetto® Tissue Napkin Pockets are a simple way to bring everyday eating occasions where hygiene and convenience are the priority. Add cutlery alongside the pre-inserted, 2-ply Tissue napkin to keep everything protected until your guests' food arrives.

Environmental Aspects

Product

The pockets are made from unbleached virgin fibers.

The tissue napkin is manufactured from Totally Chlorine Free pulp (TCF), or/and Elementary Chlorine Free pulp (ECF), i.e. bleaching chemicals used are oxygen, hydrogen peroxide, chlorine and ozone. The pulp is white or dyed.

The napkn is certified according to *Test Program with reference OK 2 edition D "Home compostability of products"*, No. TA8021802593.

The product is FSC certified according to "Mixed Sources" certification number DNV-COC-000148.

PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) are not intentionally being used in any step of the manufacturing of the boxes.

Packaging

The cardboard box is used to pack and protect the product and is made from virgin fiber.

The corrugated board box used for transportation is largely composed of recycled fiber.

Packaging and Packaging Waste

The packaging complies with all essential requirements as defined by PPWR (Regulation (EU) 2025/40 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 December 2024 on packaging and packaging waste). This means minimum adequate amount of packaging, limitation of heavy metal content, recyclable through at least one of the following: reuse, recycling, material recovery, energy recovery or composting (more details under Management of Used Products).

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Product Safety

The product fulfils the following:

- EU Regulation 1935/2004/EC
- EU Regulation 2023/2006/EC
- EU Regulation 10/2011/EC with amendments (Plastic regulation)
- BfR recommendation XXXVI, Paper and board for food contact and LFGB
- Order No. 681 of May 25 (2020) from Danish Ministry of Environment and Food on ban of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) in paper and cardboard food contact materials.
- Duni manufacturing units are certified according to the international quality system ISO 9001. They have also implemented the environmental management system ISO 14001.

Management of Used Products

Recycling

The boxes may be sorted with paper for recycling. However, recycling practices depend on local collection, sorting, and material acceptance policies. Always consult your local waste handler for specific recycling recommendations.

Compostability

The napkin is certified under the OK Compost Home logo, indicating it meets home compostability standards. The certification license number is TA8021802593.

The pocket is not certified for compostability and should follow local disposal recommendations.

Energy Recovery

Incineration facilities for energy recovery are dependent on local infrastructure. Incineration for energy recovery is a good alternative when material recovery is not available by recycling.

Validity

This is issued 2025-02-06. It is revised when there is a change in the manufacturing process, in the product or in legislation.
